Very Important: Clearly Label All Clothing and Belongings

School Dress

- Oxford, button down shirts (4)
- Polo shirts (2)
- Pants/colored denim (5)
- Khaki shorts (early fall and late spring only) (3)
- Skirts – *length just above knee* (4)
- Tights/stockings (2)
- Belts (1)
- Dresses (no strapless or camisole dresses) (4)
- Blazer (1)
- Sweaters and cardigans (2)
- Vests (2)
- Ties (3)
- School shoes, closed toe (2)
- Underclothing
- Socks (10)
- Sneakers (2)

Relaxed Dress /Athletics

- T-shirts (10)
- Shorts (5)
- Sweatpants and sweatshirt (3 each)
- Cleats and sneakers (1 each)
- Athletic socks (10)
- *Jog-style/sports bras (5)
- *Supporter/Cup
- Bathrobe (1)
- Pajamas (5)
- Jeans (3)

Outdoor Gear

- Winter hats, gloves, and scarf (2 each)
- Winter boots (1)
- Raincoat (1)
- Spring/Fall jacket (1)
- Winter jacket (1)
- Water bottle

Toiletries & Supplies

- Toothbrush & toothpaste
- Deodorant & foot powder

- Shampoo, conditioner, & body soap
- Shower Caddy

Other Supplies

- [Basic school supplies](#)
- Healthy snacks (dry goods) and drinks (no caffeine) for the food bin.

Bedding & Towels

- Bath towels
- Twin sheets (two sets): 39” x 75” – (2) flat, (2) fitted
- Pillow (at least 1) and pillow cases (2)
- Mattress pad (optional, but recommended)
- Comforter or quilt
- Extra blanket

Room Décor

- Clothes hangers
- Alarm clock
- Desk lamp
- Wall décor, posters, pictures
- Removable poster putty, tape, mounting strips.
- Laundry basket

Optional Items

- Reusable cutlery, cup, and bowl.
- Small fan (no air circulating fans)
- Power strip with surge protector
- Backpack
- Umbrella
- Bicycle & helmet
- mp3 player (optional, but recommended)

Prohibited Items

- Inappropriate (R-rated) décor/entertainment
- Weapons
- Televisions
- Candles and incense
- Hot pots, electric heaters, and refrigerators
- Pets
- LED lights
- Medications (must go to health center)
