Games are typically on Wednesday and Friday afternoons, but may involve a Saturday. Practices are between 3:00 pm and 5:00 pm on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays and the season ends on June 1, 2026.

Responsibilities:

- Provide immediate emergency care during times of physical activity, including being present at interscholastic events
- Responsible for evaluation and emergency care of sports related injuries, concussion protocols, injury prevention and rehabilitation
- Provide respectful communication, within limits of confidentiality, on student health matters between coaches, parents and health care providers
- Maintain complete and accurate records and pertinent medical data
